

The Risk assessment for the Pals work party is given below –
 Though restrictions have been lifted, be thoughtful of others and keep a good distance from others when working.

Avoid sharing work equipment by allocating it on a personal basis. **Otherwise keep those you are issued with and clean after use**

Basic first aid kit on site, including bottled water to flush any objects in eyes and anti bacterial handwash

Meet at ten at the garden of rest tool shed, or find the group working throughout site, mainly on top of mound and long steps
